Ask a grandparent or other older adult to tell you a story from their childhood.	Draw a picture outside using chalk.	Send a postcard to the Library while traveling. If you aren't traveling this summer, send a card to someone who lives far away.
Watch a movie based on a book. Title:	Make a craft using only recycled materials found in your home.	Attend any Library program.	Check out and read a folk or fairy tale. <i>(Folk & Fairy Tales can be found under 398 in non-fiction)</i> Title:	Build a pillow fort. Read with a flashlight inside your fort!
Read a non-fiction book on space, space travel, or any subject that interests you. Title:	Find shapes in the clouds with a friend or family member. Do you both see the same thing?	Play a game outside as a family. <i>(Red Light, Green Light is a classic!)</i>	Learn to swim! If you already know how, visit a pool or beach to practice.	Go star gazing! Draw a picture of a constellation you saw and give it to a staff member. <i>(Drawings will be displayed in the Children's Department)</i>
Tell a joke to a staff member. <i>(Joke books can be found under 818 in non-fiction)</i>	Read a book by an author unfamiliar to you. Author:	Play dress up with friends or family.	Play in the rain! Go outside while it's raining and splash in a puddle.	Experiment with sensory play! Play with playdoh, slime, or another sensory material of your choice.
